PHYSIOLOGICAL PROPERTIES

- Effects on eyes-[fresh concrete](#) will burn and cause eye irritation.
- Effects on skin-[fresh concrete](#) can cause burns to the skin.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

- Skin Contact - Flush well with water.
- Eye contact - Flush well with water for 15 to 30 minutes and seek medical attention.
